

Short Bio: Pear Pongsachareonnont Ferreira, MD, MPH

Dr. Pear Pongsachareonnont Ferreira is Assistant Professor of Ophthalmology at Chulalongkorn University. She is the head of the Research Unit, department of Ophthalmology, Chulalongkorn University. She graduated with her vitreoretinal fellowship from the University of Toronto, Canada, and MPH in Epidemiology from Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public health.

Her main research area is retinal imaging, vitreoretinal surgery, and the quality of life in visual impairment patients. She is currently a principal investigator of several clinical trials related to a new drug in Thailand. She has served as a secretary of the ASEAN Ophthalmology Society (AOS) and member of the American Society of Retina Specialists (ASRS) and the Thai Retina Society (TRS). Dr. Ferreira is also a board member of local IRB in the Faculty of Medicine, Chulalongkorn University, and the organizing committee for the Standard Course in Clinical Trial and GCP training.
